Where can I get more information about the Australian Fair Pay Commission's decision?

The Workplace Authority is providing information on the Australian Fair Pay Commission's general Wage-Setting Decision 2008 through the **Workplace Infoline** on **1300 363 264**.

- information for special FMWs for employees with a disability; and
- information for casual and piece rate workers.
