2008 Minimum Wage Review submissions available online

The Australian Fair Pay Commission today announced **83** written submissions were received from interested groups and individuals to its 2008 Minimum Wage Review.

The Commission is posting **81** non-confidential submissions on its website at www.fairpay.gov.au.

Australian Fair Pay Commission Acting Chair, Professor Judith Sloan, said the submissions came from a wide range of stakeholders including individuals; community, employee, employer and education and professional organisations; governments and private businesses.

“The Commission received **38** submissions from employer, employee, community and professional stakeholder organisations, **10** from governments and government agencies, and **35** from individuals and private businesses.

“The Commissioners would like to thank all those groups and individuals who made submissions to the 2008 Minimum Wage Review.

“The submissions, together with research and information gathered by the Commission during stakeholder meetings and consultations, will help inform the 2008 Minimum Wage Review.

“The Commission will not comment on the submissions received, or matters raised within the submissions at this time. However, when the 2008 Minimum Wage Decision is announced in July, the decision document will outline the Commission’s key considerations,” she said.
