Where can I get more information about the Australian Fair Pay Commission's decision?

The Fair Work Ombudsman is providing information on the Australian Fair Pay Commission's general Wage-Setting Decision 2009 through the **Fair Work Infoline** on **13 13 94**.

The **Fair Work Infoline** provides up-to-date information on wages and conditions to employees, employers, representative organisations and community groups.

The **Fair Work Infoline** will provide the following information about the Commission's wage-setting decision:

- what is included in the decision;
- current minimum rates of pay as set by the Federal Minimum Wage and in transitional Australian Pay and Classification Scales;
- information on special Federal Minimum Wages for employees with disability;
- information on minimum wages for junior employees and employees covered by training arrangements; and
- information for casual and piece rate workers.
